

Educational Opportunity Foundation of the Black Forest (EOF) Application for Academic or Vocational Scholarship 2026

Thank you for applying for our scholarship. Below is a list of criteria that must be met in order for your application to be considered. Please initial at the bottom of each page to accept these guidelines.

Section 1: Application Instructions

1. Scholarships will be awarded for either vocational or academic pursuits.
2. Candidates must be a graduating high school senior (December 2025 or May/June 2026 graduation dates). Note, 5-year high school students or gap year applicants will *not* be considered for this scholarship.
3. The EOF Board of Directors will consider the following criteria for the selection of scholarship recipients:
 - a. Financial need
 - b. Student character
 - c. Community service, especially in the Black Forest community
 - d. Student goals
 - e. Academic performance (including course work and standardized test scores)
 - f. Extracurricular activities
4. Applicants must reside in Black Forest as determined by the following boundary lines (reference the EOF website):
 - a. The north boundary is County Line Road of El Paso County and Douglas County.
 - b. The west boundary begins at the intersection of the north boundary and Highway 83. It continues south through the intersection of Powers Boulevard and Highway 83 southward to the intersection of Powers to Old Ranch Road.
 - c. The southern boundary continuing eastward along Old Ranch Road to Black Forest Road (including the line through private property where Old Ranch Road is interrupted). It curves southward to follow Black Forest Road to Woodman Road. The line continues east on Woodman to Meridian Road.
 - d. The eastern boundary is Meridian Road northward to County Line Road.
 - e. The area includes all of the 80908 zip code and sections of the 80106 zip code. Please check the map on our website to confirm.
5. The following information **MUST** be complete and uploaded to the Black Forest EOF website, together in one package, by the scholarship deadline (February 16, 2026 no later than 11:59pm Mountain Standard time).
 - a. A complete and signed application. Incomplete applications will not be considered.
 - b. A 2"x 3" head and shoulders photograph of the applicant.
 - c. Two (2) letters of recommendation, one of which **MUST** be from a teacher who can attest to your academic performance. A second letter **MUST** be from a professional mentor or supervisor who can attest to your work, volunteer, or extracurricular activities. Do not forget to request these letters in advance of the deadline, as they must be included with your application package. Only two letters of recommendation please. ****NOTE -** No letters from applicant's parents or relatives will be accepted.
 - d. An official high school transcript or GED certificate.
 - e. Your ACT and/or SAT scores.
 - f. Your essay (academic scholarship application) or your essay/project (vocational application). See application for more information.
 - g. A release for name and/or image of applicant used for website, media, or promotional purposes.

The scholarship application upload deadline with all components of your package from section 5(a-g) above is due no later than Monday, February 16 at 11:59pm Mountain Standard time. ****NOTE – only complete application packages received by this date will move on to the interview phase.**

Section 2: Student Requirements

1. Each applicant selected for the interview phase is expected to attend an in-person interview session on either Tuesday, February 24 or Thursday, February 26, 2026. The interview time and date will be coordinated between applicant and EOF's Board Secretary. We try to be flexible on the times of these interviews, but applicants should make themselves available for this part of the process. Business attire is recommended.
2. Awardees are required to attend the Scholarship Awards Banquet at a TBD date in April, 2026. See website for updates.
 - a. Failure to RSVP for the interview, banquet or other deadline dates listed below will result in forfeiture of the scholarship. (See important dates below).
 - b. Scholarship recipients must be enrolled in an educational/vocational institution by October 1, 2026.
 - c. Scholarship funds must be requested by October 31, 2026. Funds will only be sent by EOF directly to the institution (trade/vocational school or college/university), and only to be used for tuition, fees or required course books and materials.
3. Scholarships not claimed by the requested deadlines will be forfeited by applicant.

Vocational applicants will provide either an essay as described above, or include a presentation that demonstrates your interest and talent in an applicable vocational field. Examples may include a summarization of your internship in a forest fire mitigation program, a creative art portfolio, descriptions and renderings of original industrial designs, an automobile engine rebuilding project, an original fashion design portfolio, an electrical design of a proposed robot, or an original designed computer application, and many more ideas. You are encouraged to bring examples of your work to your interview.

Letters of Recommendation

Two letters of recommendation as noted in Scholarship Instructions must be included and uploaded with your application and received no later than February 16, 2026 at 11:59pm Mountain Standard time.
